What we do

Same day HIV testing

Available by appointment on a Monday or Thursday. This service includes counselling with a Health Advisor before taking a test and upon receiving the result.

HIV testing is also available by appointment from Monday to Friday during clinic hours. results will be ready within 2-4 days and must be collected in person.
