The Course

The course is accredited by the Sheffield Centre for HIV and Sexual Health and is designed to enable participants to gain sufficient awareness, confidence and skills to develop HIV/AIDS training for a wide range of organisations and groups.

We shall be exploring HIV related issues such as sexuality, prejudice, oppression, drugs and loss. We will consider our own responses to these issues as well as looking at how we might work on them with others.

The Training

The training is participatory and works with the experience that members of the group bring. There will be work in pairs and small groups and the training environment will be safe and supportive. Participants will be expected to attend every session.

The Trainers

Carol Painter is a freelance trainer working in the field of HIV/AIDS and related issues. She is accredited as an Assertiveness and Sexuality Trainer by Redwood Women's Training Association. She is also accredited by Redwood as a Trainer of Trainers.

Kate Quail is the Training Manager at the Sheffield Centre for HIV and Sexual Health. She has organised and facilitated a wide variety of highly successful and innovative training programmes around HIV and AIDS, including local and national Train the Trainers courses.

Both trainers have a strong commitment to equal opportunities and personal development. They have worked extensively in the statutory and voluntary sectors across the country.

Module 1

January 19th, 20th, 21st, 22nd 1993

This module will focus on establishing the group and setting an agenda of issues and concerns raised for participants by HIV and AIDS.

We then go on to look at prejudice and oppression. We shall look at how they work on a personal and societal level and how they can be challenged.

Module 2

February 9th, 10th, 11th 1993

In this module we shall be focussing on sexuality. We shall be exploring our attitudes and feelings to a range of issues around sexual practice and sexual choice. We will then look at the implications this raises for sexuality training within the context of HIV.

Module 3

March 2nd, 3rd, 4th 1993

This module will focus on identifying and practicing good training and group work skills, for example creating a safe, yet challenging training environment, confronting prejudice and dealing with difficult feelings.

Participants will have an opportunity to practice what they have learned. They will prepare and present materials and get feedback from the trainers and the other participants. The course will end with peer assessment, review and suggestions for additional training needs.
