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You've fallen in love, and this is going to be forever. Only, if you're honest, you know that this has happened before and it didn't last. Something went wrong and you don't want that to happen again. You want to please and you want to impress. You're careful about what you tell your partner and you may even tell a few white lies to make your sex life sound good. Do you really know each other?

Of course you know each other - you don't go with anyone. She's a friend of your sister or he used to go to the same school. But if you want to get really close, you want to know the **personal** things about each other. What makes him so special to you? What makes being with her so unforgettable?

If you want to get really close, get to know each other first. There's lots of things you can try.
There's kissing, cuddling, tickling, stroking,
massage and fondling.

Why get to know your partner?

- so you can be intimate so you can trust each other
- so you can learn what pleases each other so that if anything goes wrong, you'll be confident enough with each other to talk it through.

If and when you're ready for sexual intercourse, (and most people wait till they're 16 or over) you'll be able to make a decision together about how to protect each other from risk - of pregnancy and

### REMEMBER!

- Safer sex includes hugging, kissing, stroking, massage, masturbating each other or any contact which does not involve contact between yours and your partner's body fluids (the man's semen or the woman's vaginal fluids).
- Safer sex lowers the risk of getting HIV (the virus that can lead to AIDS) and other STDs. It also lowers the risk of pregnancy.
- You CAN become infected with HIV
  - from having sexual intercourse with an infected
  - person or by sharing needles or syringes with an infected
- The more people you have unsafe sex with, the higher the risk of becoming infected with HIV (and all sexually transmitted infections).
- If and when you have sexual intercourse, always (and that means always! use a condom.

  If you want to avoid a pregnancy, use another reliable method of contraception as well.
- You can learn how to use a condom and get free advice and supplies for all methods of contraception at your local family planning clinic or Brook Advisory Centre.
