- Last year a third of us who fucked or got fucked, did so without a condom and many of us did it with a regular sexual partner or lover.
- That safer sex is the same whether we are **POSITIVE** or **NEGATIVE** isn't true, there **are** differing health implications depending on our HIV status. We also make choices depending on the relationships we have with each other and the kind of sex that we have, either casual, anonymous or in relationships.
- With differing health concerns to deal with we need to develop personal ways of looking after our sexual health and deciding if this means using condoms. As well as the reasons that we have to use condoms there are equally valid reasons why many of us choose not to. This is not a recommendation to stop using condoms, but a recognition that sometimes we don't and what this can mean for each of us.
