The easiest way to prevent HIV transmission is to use an extra strong condom and water-based lubricant whenever you fuck. Safer sex can often be that simple. But what about when it isn't? Maybe, if you or your partner want to stop using condoms, or you find using them a problem, it might be a good idea to go together to see a health advisor at a sexual health clinic for confidential advice. This will give you the opportunity to discuss the risks of HIV and will let you both be open and honest in a safe environment. Relationships take love and courage. Why not talk to each other about how you feel?
