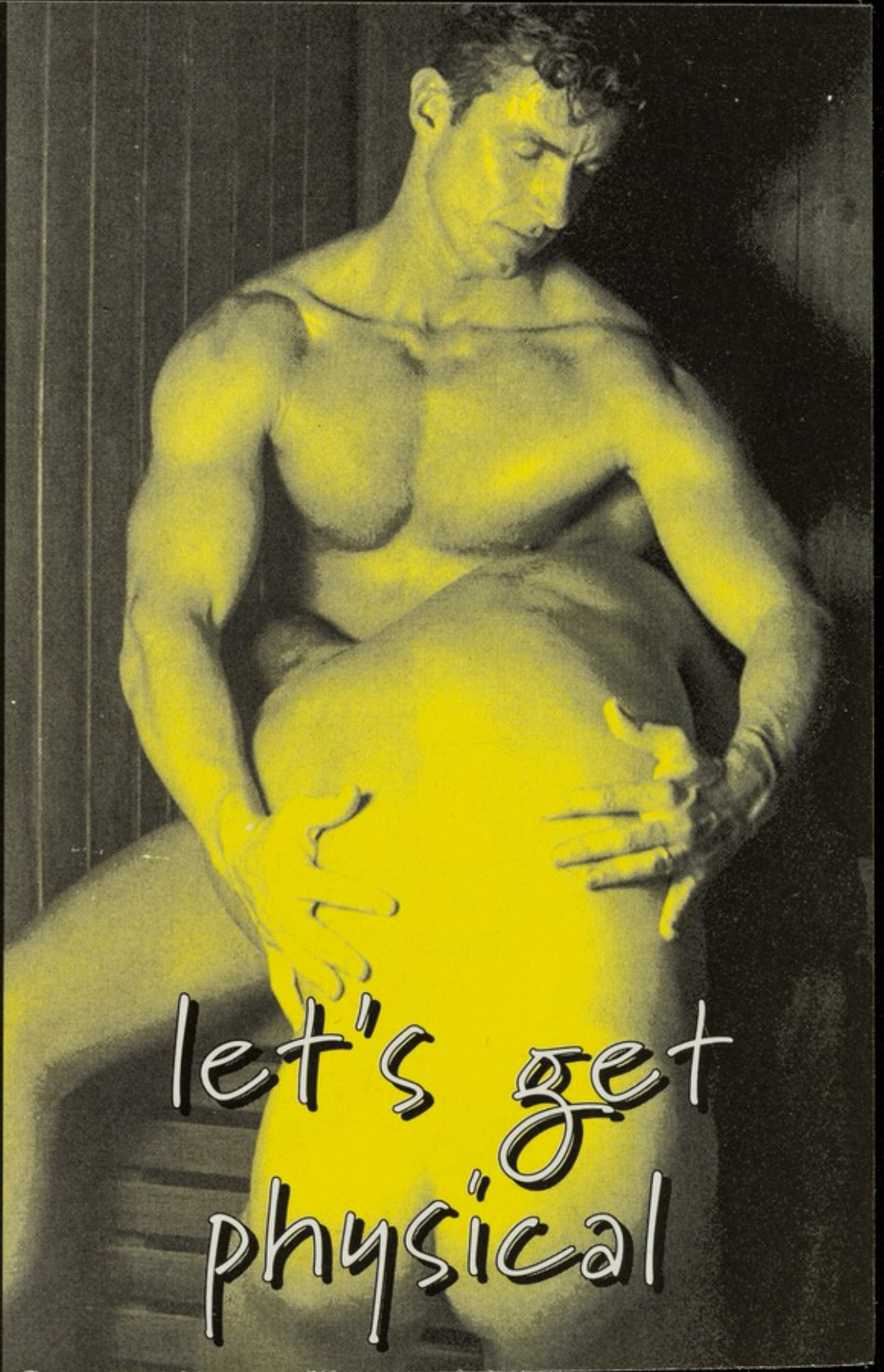

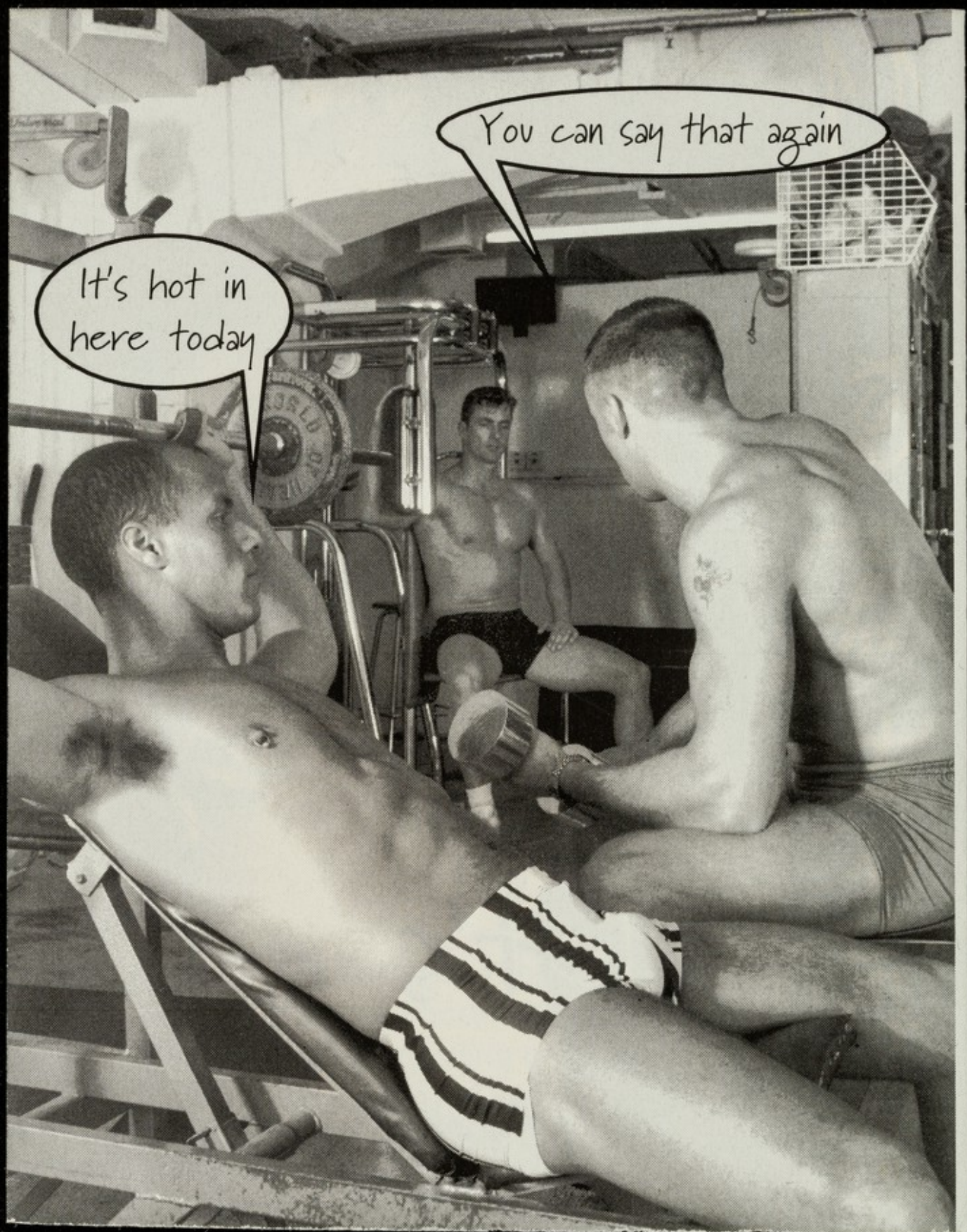

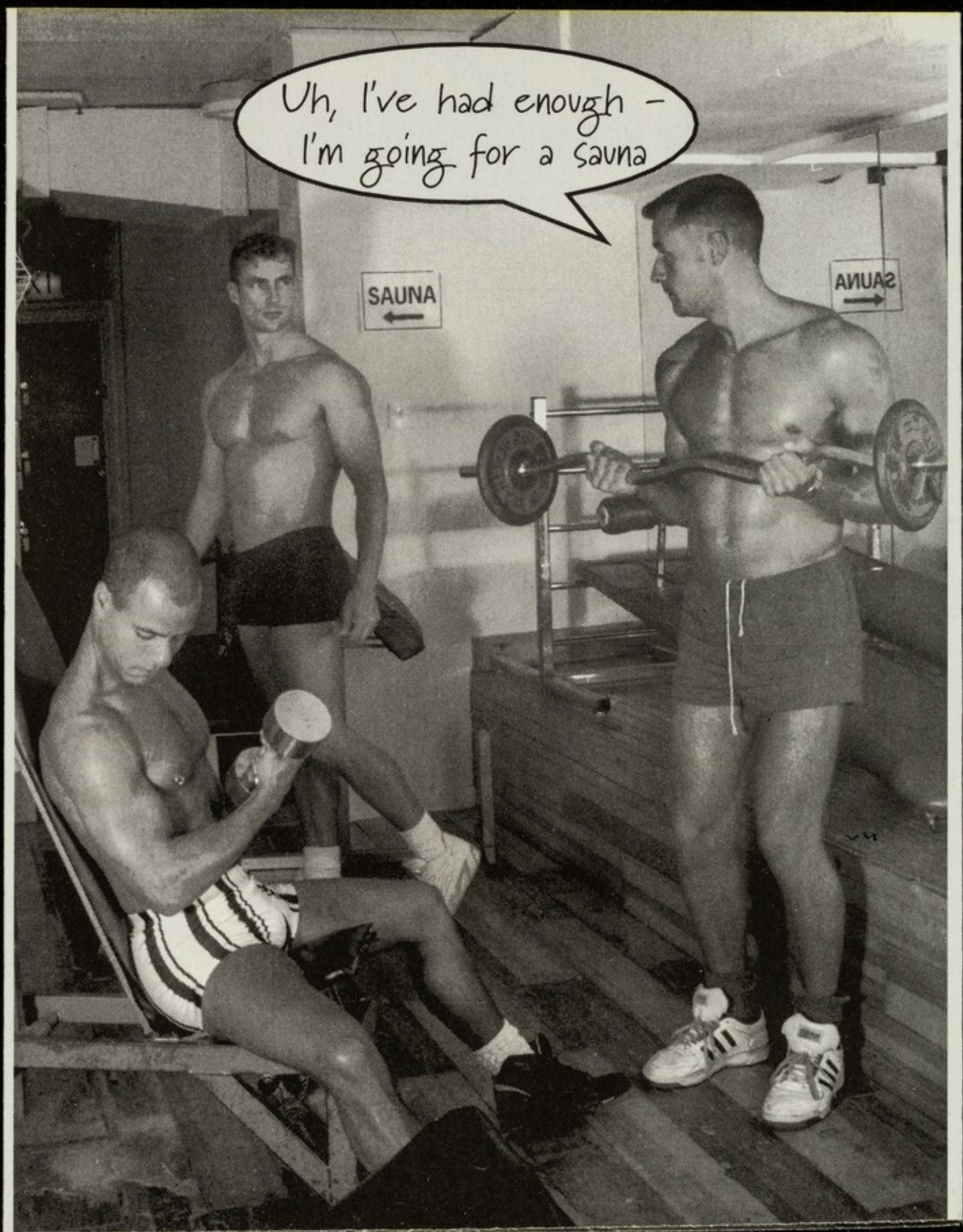

You can say that again

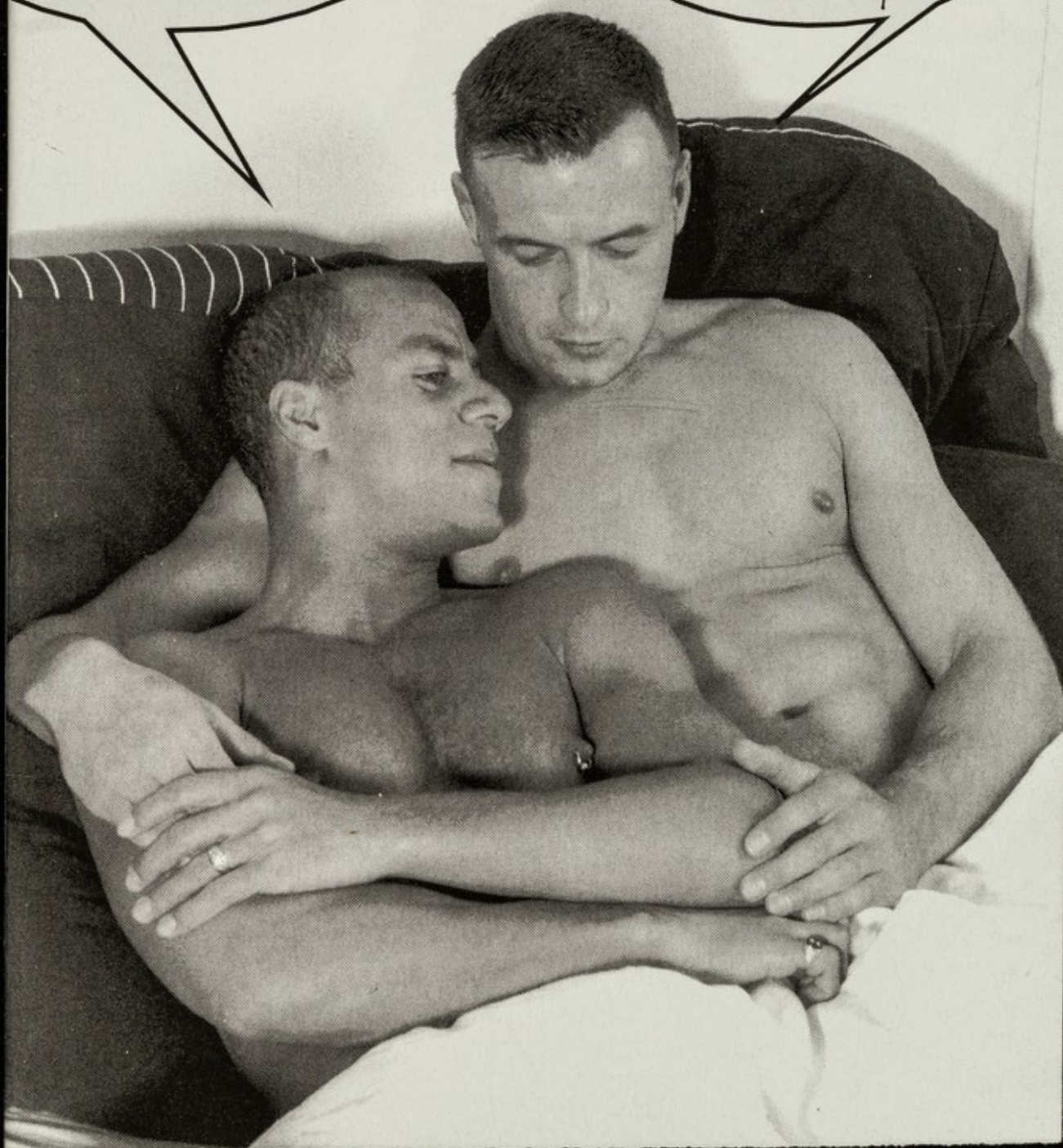
Uh, I've had enough -

risk to anyone



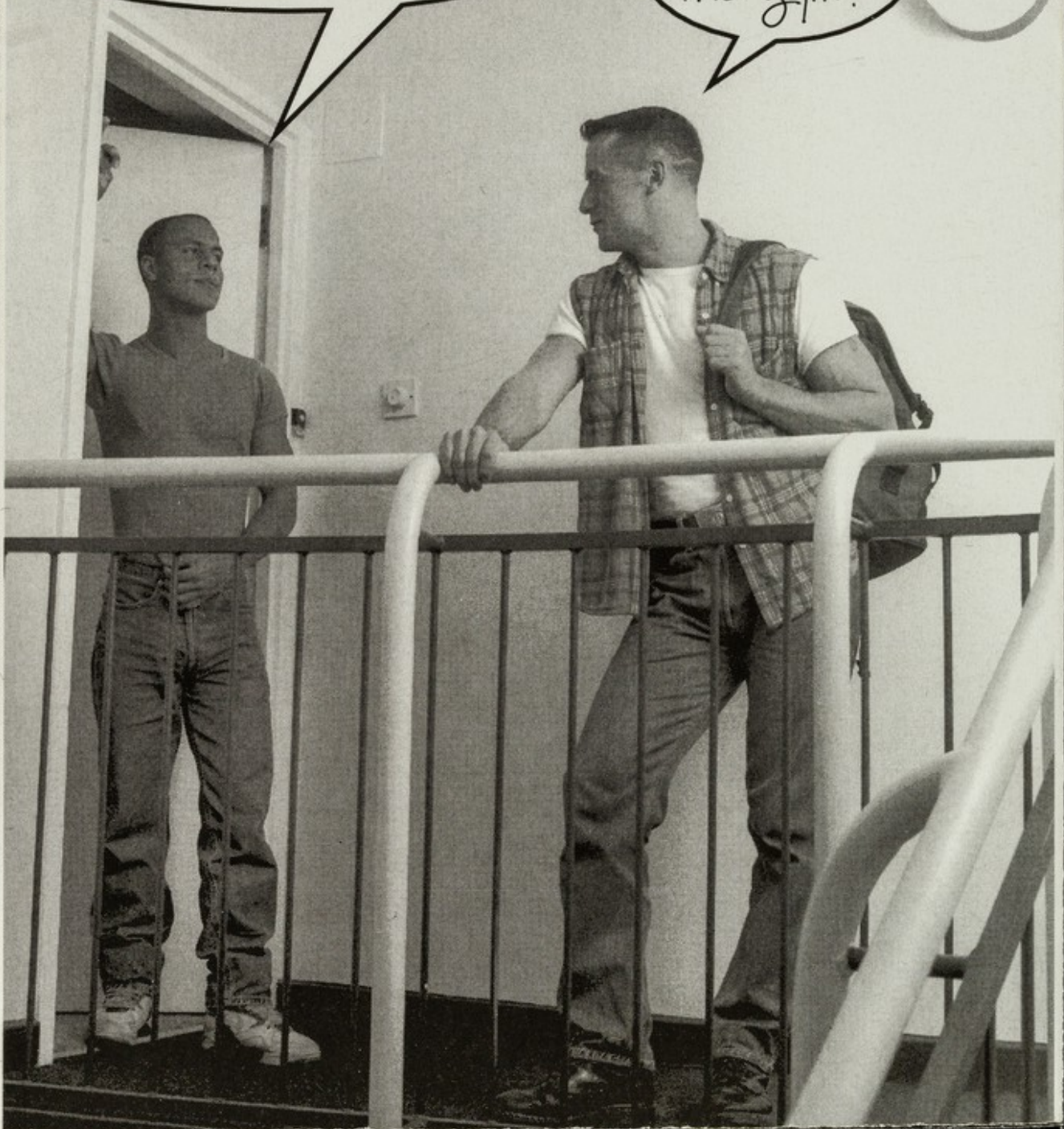
Remember Tony,
