Our progress so far

The Terrence Higgins Trust was founded in 1983 to inform, advise and help on AIDS and HIV infection, to disseminate accurate information about AIDS and HIV and provide health education. We provide welfare, legal and counselling support to all people affected by AIDS and HIV infection, and to their partners, friends and families.

These are some of our services:

HELPLINE AND COUNSELLING

We offer a telephone helpline and counselling to anyone who needs to talk to someone about AIDS or HIV. In 1989, we answered over 15,000 telephone enquiries to our Helpline and helped more than 600 people with face to face counselling.

FAMILY SUPPORT

Our family support network helps the families of people with AIDS and encourages mutual support between families who have experienced the death of a person with AIDS.

BUDDYING

Buddies give one to one help and support to people with AIDS, providing practical help, care and friendship. We have over 300 trained volunteers and we aim to provide buddy support for anyone that needs it regardless of race, gender or sexuality.

EDUCATION

The Terrence Higgins Trust provides health education services to youth groups, schools and the media. We tell people how to avoid becoming infected with HIV or AIDS and advise those with AIDS on how to maintain a healthier lifestyle.
