- an electronic textbook
- complete text of over 8,000 journal articles
- abstracts and listings from major HIV databases

- Global AIDS statistics from the *Weekly epidemiological record*

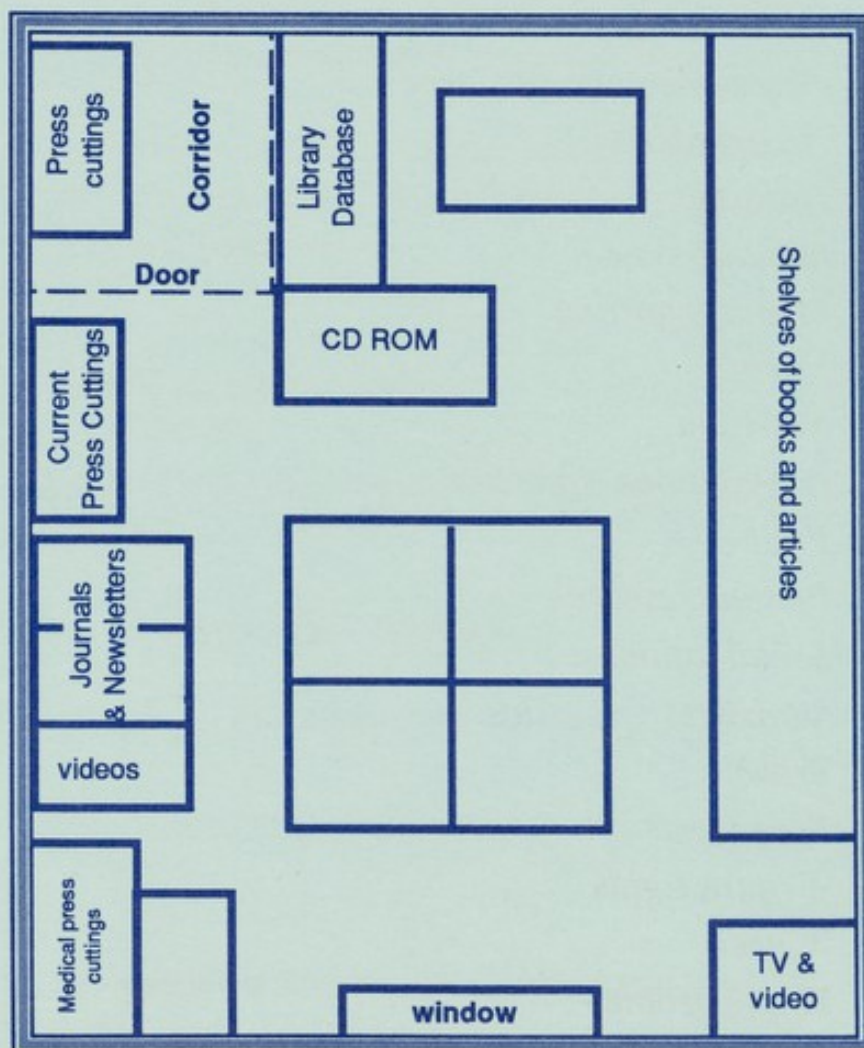
*** there is a comprehensive range of over 150 journals and newsletters including**
