HOW YOU CAN HELP

You can help the Legal Centre to provide a full range of services by making a donation to the Terrence Higgins Trust. Please send your donation to the Legal and Welfare Assistant at the Trust.

We plan to expand the services offered by the Legal Centre and to employ a qualified experienced solicitor and a Legal Information Officer. The Centre can then seek Law Centre status and so be able to represent users in court, undertake a larger case load and deal with a wider range of legal problems.

If you wish to give on a regular basis you can do so using a Bankers Order. If you are in employment, the Give As You Earn Scheme allows you to do the same without paying tax on your donation. Check whether your employer is a member of this scheme.

If you are an income tax payer you can also donate by making a covenant (using the form overleaf). At the basic rate of tax for every £1 given, the Terrence Higgins Trust is able to recover 34p from the Inland Revenue.

If you are a solicitor, remember the Terrence Higgins Trust as a potential beneficiary under clients' wills.
