AVERT, the AIDS Education and Research Trust, is a national AIDS charity that aims to prevent people from becoming infected with HIV, to improve the quality of life for those already infected and to work with others to develop a cure.

Through education and the funding of medical research, AVERT has for ten years been actively "AVERTing AIDS".



Medical Research

AVERT is one of the main UK AIDS charities funding medical research to understand more about the disease with the long term goal of finding a cure.

Our current projects include a study based at St. Bartholomew's Hospital, London into how the virus attacks and destroys the immune system. Understanding these mechanisms is vital if improved drugs and medicines are to be developed which will slow down and ideally reverse the process.

Another AVERT funded project is The National Study of HIV in Pregnancy and Childhood based at the Institute of Child Health in London.

We estimate that by the year 2000, 30–40 million men, women and children will be infected with HIV.
