## AN INFORMATION ROOM

based in the Body Positive centre, which stocks a wide variety of publications and books. The collection includes books, treatment and medical journals, an international newsletter collection, back issues of the Body Positive Newsletter, leaflets and directories. The collection is available for reference use only but a limited photocopying service is available. The information room is open and staffed during the following hours:

Mon and Fri: 11-9pm, Sun, Tues, Weds and Thurs: 11-5pm.

The information room is also open during the women's only session on Tues 6-9pm

### LEAFLETS

### **SPEAKERS**

Body Positive has a number of committed volunteers who are able to talk to groups of people in schools, colleges, universities and also to professionals such as social workers, doctors etc about their personal experiences of living with HIV/AIDS. ## OPEN MORNINGS

are held every Thursday at the drop-in centre from 9.45 to I Iam. ### NEWSLETTER

is a national publication written by and for people affected by HIV and AIDS. Its prime function is to reach people affected by HIV/AIDS who don't have easy access to organised support facilities and to counteract the isolation they might feel. Articles cover a wide range of topics from information on new drugs and treatments to personal experiences. It also carries features on welfare benefits, women's issues and information on alternative therapies. The Notice board section gives details of events, support groups and organisations across the country. The Newsletter also carries Personal Ads for those wishing to meet other people affected by HIV/AIDS. The Diary section keeps readers up to date with events at the BP London Drop-In Centre.

The newsletter is available on cassette to anyone who has difficulties with reading.
