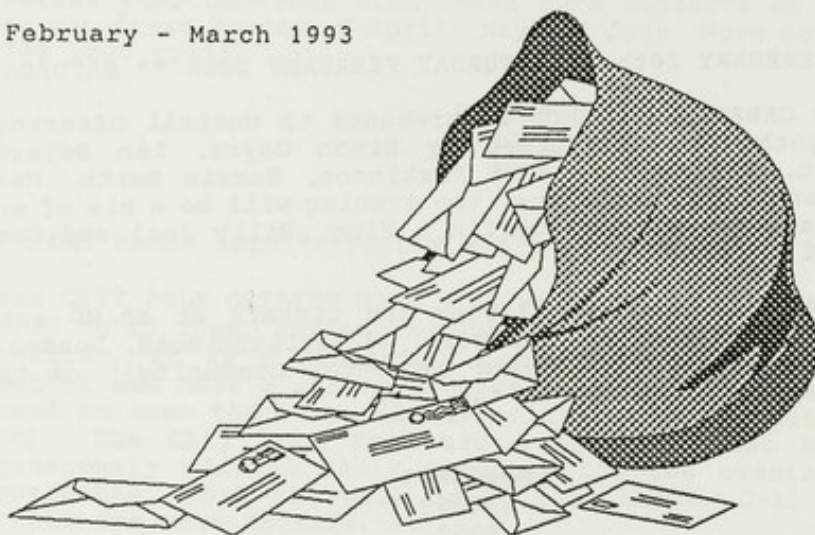

Toyah is well known through her work on stage, film and TV as well as her musical career, and Tim is at present best known for playing Robin Stokes in "The Archers", but also has an impressive list of stage and TV appearances to his name.

Accompanying them will be JONATHAN DOVE, pianist, composer, arranger, accompanist, conductor and lecturer. Jonathan is well known in the music and theatre world, and has worked on productions for Glyndebourne, ENO, the Almeida Theatre, National Theatre and City of Birmingham Touring Opera.
