Big Up is an organisation that provides culturally sensitive and specific HIV information, education and prevention for African and Caribbean men who have sex with men.

Our volunteers are able to draw on a database of valuable agencies and organisations providing services that are sensitive and suited to the needs of Black men who have sex with men. Workshops

Big Up believes that we all should take responsibility for ourselves and our lives.

At Big Up we believe that it is through education that we empower ourselves to make informed choices about our sexual health. To achieve this we have developed a number of workshops providing accurate. up-to-date information about HIV and AIDS alongside other issues that explore diverse topics including negotiating safer sex, relationships, health issues and self development.

Our workshops are open to all Black men who have sex with men.

Pesitively Black

We recognise that some of the needs & issues for Black men living with HIV or AIDS are separate & different from those who are not. In response to this we have developed a nine week course for Black men who are living with HIV or AIDS.

The course explores coping with a new diagnosis, treatment options, getting the most from you doctor, work and benefit options, healthier lifestyles, and relationships & sex. We run the nine week course throughout the year.

We have also developed a monthly support group for men living with HIV or AIDS. Held monthly at Big Up, the "Positively Black" group has been developed to provide Black men affected by HIV with a safe space to share and receive support and information about the services and treatments available to them, to discuss any issues with other HIV+ men or just to chill and watch a movie.

Safer Sex Posters, Cards and Leaflets

At Big Up we recognise the need to produce culturally sensitive and relevant safer sex posters and leaflets targeted at Black men who have sex with men.



We produce high quality, relevant, erotic and informative posters and leaflets that celebrate sex and encourage you to make informed choices about your sexual activity. These will be distributed to Genito-Urinary Clinics (GUM) clinics, other organisations and social events.

Outreach

At Big Up we recognise that for reasons such as race, sexual myths and harassment large numbers of Black Men who have sex with men, will not make use of the wider, predominately white gay commercial scene. Therefore we believe in taking our work out into our communities. We work closely with club and party promoters to do condom & information drops at their venues.

We have also developed an outreach programme with the LADS project to do Condom drops in cruising grounds and cottages. So wherever Black men who have sex with men meet Big Up will be there to provide the information and tools for them to practise safer sex.

If you are a promoter Big Up can provide condoms and lubricants to be distributed to men who attend your clubs or parties. In return we can help with the publicity of your event. If you want more information call our office.

Training


At Big Up we aim to raise the awareness and needs of Black Men who have sex with men both amongst other organisations and the wider community. We provide consultancy and training to those seeking to work with Black Men who have sex with men.

Volunteers

Volunteers are essential to the work of Big Up.

We rely on volunteers to perform many of our functions. Volunteers run the helpline, outreach, workshops, publicity and promotions as well as providing administrative support. Volunteers also assist with the development of our HIV prevention campaigns and the planning and delivery of events such as Gay Pride and World AIDS Day.

All of our volunteers take part in a weekend long induction course that covers, amongst other issues, HIV awareness, confidentiality and the work that they will be carrying out for Big Up. After the induction each volunteer is interviewed separately by the volunteer co-ordinator. Following this interview volunteers are allocated work group




The Volunteers Support Group meets every six weeks with the volunteer co-ordinator to discuss future work and any problems.
