One quarter of the families that we support have less than £20 a week to spend on food for their household.

By making a regular donation to support our work, you will ensure that vital nutrition services reach those most in need. Good nutrition is essential to strengthen the immune system, maintain a healthy weight and support the effectiveness of medication.

Your Donation of...

£3.50 will provide a hot nutritious main meal and dessert, and a cold light meal for someone who is housebound and isolated

£5 will provide a meal for a single mother and her child living with HIV

£10 will provide a seasonal hamper of extra food for a family affected by HIV

£15 a month will provide two nutritious meals every Sunday for a housebound person living with HIV

£33 will provide an emergency food hamper for someone just out of hospital or in a financial crisis

All of the services we provide are free of charge thanks to the invaluable commitment of over 800 volunteers who are involved in every part of the organisation and the delivery of our services.

Our Services

A tailored hot Sunday lunch is delivered to the doors of people living with HIV, and their families and carers.

Our emergency hampers contain nutritious, easy-to-prepare foods, for critically ill people upon leaving hospital – or for those in a financial crisis.

Grocery boxes are available to those who are housebound, isolated and unable to shop for themselves.
