Did you know?

Over 50% of all new HIV infections are now occurring in young people in the 10-24 age group. Five young people are infected with HIV every minute in the world

Rates of Gonorrhoea, Chlamydia, Genital Herpes and Genital warts are highest amongst young people, and teenage girls are most infected

More than one-in-five people aged 18-20 and over and one-in-seven aged 16-17 said they had unprotected sex with a new partner in the past year

There are over 270 South Asian people living in the UK with an AIDS diagnosis

Young South Asian gay men are the largest group of infected people amongst the Asian community
