A guide to services for African Users

This audio tape will specifically focus on issues that families from African communities face when dealing with HIV/AIDS. These issues are essentially relevant to all Black families. The intention is to assist families in understanding what services are available and ways of accessing HIV/AIDS services. The play will consist of three family members and a family friend. The emphasis will be on families long established in England with community connections. This is a very close knit extended family. There has been a family divided over the last 6 months when Mama Turmin's niece returned to Uganda because her parents feared her behaviour would lead to her disgracing the family. Mama Turmin did not agree to her brother returning his daughter back home. Relations have been very diplomatic from this point.
