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

the Centre a focus for people
affected by HIV.



FACTS: the Foundation for AIDS
Counselling, Treatment and
Support was founded in the mid
1980's by Dr Andrew Heley to
provide medical care in the
community to people affected by
HIV. The Centre, which was
opened by HRH the Princess of
Wales in 1991, is continually
expanding the range of services it
offers to the community.
Volunteers work alongside fulltime staff in many areas.



A medical clinic, advice, support and a range of complementary therapies are available as well as a gym, meeting rooms and coffee lounge.

FACTS provides community based care sensitive to the needs of our patients and other users. Direct medical care is just one aspect: emotional support and practical help may be needed too. Now FACTS also provides training and education as well as non-medical services from the Centre in North London.



Medical Services

The FACTS Centre provides a specialist medical practice dedicated to caring for people with HIV and AIDS within the community.

All medical services are free to anyone affected by HIV and AIDS.

Non-Medical Services

The FACTS team is committed to an holistic approach to the care of people with HIV and AIDS.

Complementary therapies are fundamental in maintaining a better quality of life and reducing stress levels in people with HIV and AIDS.

Training and Education

The multidisciplinary team at FACTS responds to identified training needs and also organises custom-made training for other agencies and organisations.
