WHO ARE WE?

We are an independent voluntary organisation and we are part of a national network of Crossroads Care Attendant Schemes. We are, in the main, a Respite Care Service for Carers, and we also offer service to people with the HIV virus and people living with AIDS, who may or may not have an identified carer.

WHAT ARE OUR AIMS AND OBJECTIVES?

- To support people with the HIV virus and people living with AIDS.
- To be a service which is both sensitive and responsive to the needs of the people who use it.
- To help prevent the re-admission to hospital or long-term residential care of the cared-for person.
- 4. To help relieve some of the stress encountered by carers as a result of their caring responsibilities.
- 5. To help prevent breakdown of the caring relationship.

WHAT DO WE OFFER?

We provide a fully confidential service through our trained, salaried care attendants who will call to your home at a mutually agreed time each week. During these visits the care attendant will work to your requirements in as flexible a way as possible. They will perform or assist with personal care tasks, housework, shopping, etc. We provide service between 7.30am and 10.30pm, inclusive of weekends. You can avail of our service in the morning, afternoon or evening, which ever time best suits your needs. Lewisham Crossroads is not, however, an emergency service, and is, therefore, unfortunately not able to provide a night service.

WHO FUNDS US?

Lewisham Social Services funds what we call our main core and childrens service. The South-East Regional Health Authority funds our HIV/AIDS service. On a weekly basis we manage approximately 500 care hours. At present, 80 of these hours are reserved for people with the HIV virus or are living with AIDS.

The service is, of course, entirely free to our users.
