HIV AWARENESS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

Coventry Youth Action was set up in 1990 as one of a series of pilot HIV Peer Education Projects financed by the Health Education Authority, to raise awareness around HIV and related issues amongst 16 to 24 year olds.

The Coventry Project has been very successful nationally and internationally, winning awards for its video package "Change", a resource produced by young people, for young people.

Now a part of the HIV Network, we can offer the following:

GROUP WORKSHOPS - on HIV awareness, safer sex, negotiation and assertiveness, relationships etc. Each workshop or series of sessions, is planned to meet the specific needs of the participants. All workshops are facilitated by trained volunteers who are themselves aged 16 - 24 years.

<u>PUBLIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS</u> - e.g. sexual health on holiday, pubs and clubs safer sex events, and promotional resources.

JOINT CO-ORDINATION OF GYGL - A social support group for young gay men and lesbians in Coventry.
