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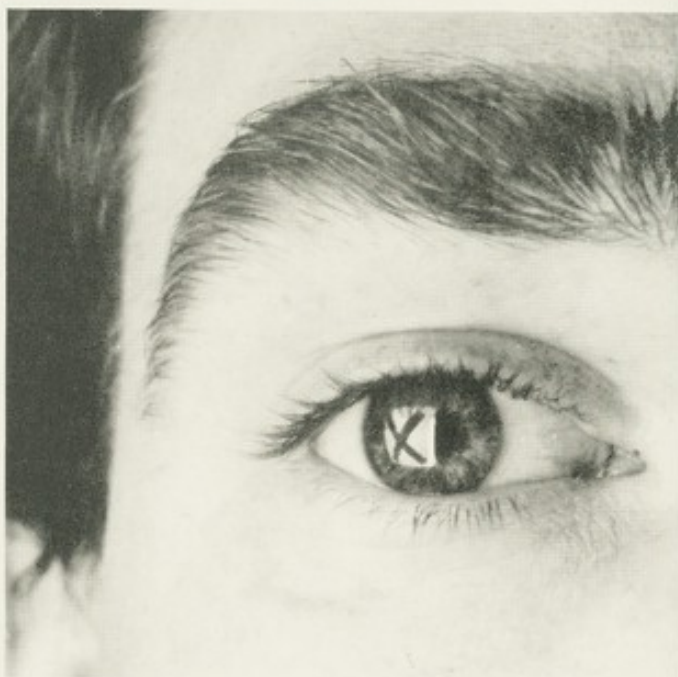

Positive choices

for people affected by HIV&AIDS

If you are resident in Kensington & Chelsea and you are affected by HIV or AIDS, you may be eligible for the following services.



Assistance with travel

Assistance with telephones

Assistance with equipment, services, holidays, and courses to enable you to maintain your health

Support and counselling for people affected by HIV (including carers, partners, family, etc)

Home care A wide-ranging and flexible home care service to help you around the house including at night where appropriate.

Day services Covering a range of professional services that may include counselling, guidance on diet and nutrition, physiotherapy/massage, art therapy.

Occupational therapy services A range of equipment and facilities may be available to help you have a more comfortable life at home.

Special support for children and families affected by HIV

Assistance from other agencies

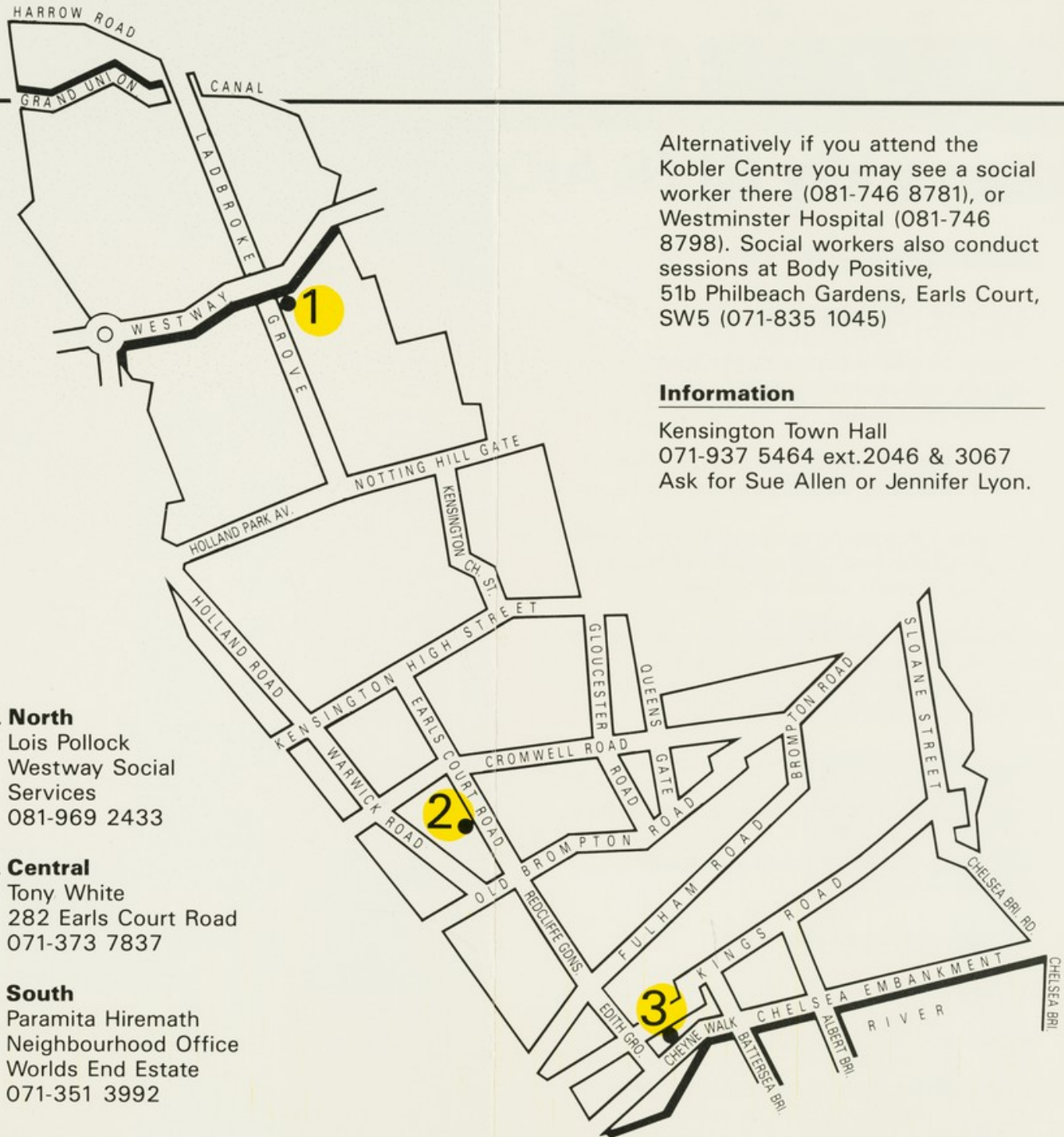
Continuing support in and out of hospital
