It is essential for everyone to receive regular advice and care of the mouth in order to

- · look and feel good
- prevent pain and infection
- enjoy an adequate and varied diet

We know that people with HIV and AIDS are more likely to have oral (mouth) and periodontal (gum) problems.

It is therefore very important that you have regular checks and receive:

- Advice on prevention of dental diseases.
- 2. Monitoring of possible changes in the mouth together with early treatment.
- 3. Regular scaling of the teeth by a dentist.


