MESMAC is a project funded by the Health Education Authority and is based in four areas in the UK-Leicester, London, Newcastle and Leeds. MESMAC takes a community development approach to health promotion with gay men and other men who have sex with men and aims to identify and meet health needs including HIV and AIDS issues. MESMAC is now in its third year and has pioneered a variety of methods of work including peer education, outreach, street work, training, publications, information, policy development, group work and so on. MESMAC has worked both at grass roots and strategic levels and influenced individuals, groups and organisations.

Much has been learned through MESMAC that has implications for other HIV / AIDS work with men who have sex with men elsewhere, HIV / AIDS work generally with Health Promotion work in a wider sense.
