**AIDS FACTS**

- HIV (Human Immuno-deficiency Virus) is the virus which causes AIDS (Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome).
- The main way that HIV is transmitted is through unprotected sex.
- You can reduce the risk of contracting HIV by using a condom during sex.
- Globally 8,500 more people are being infected with HIV everyday. More than half of these are Women and Children.
