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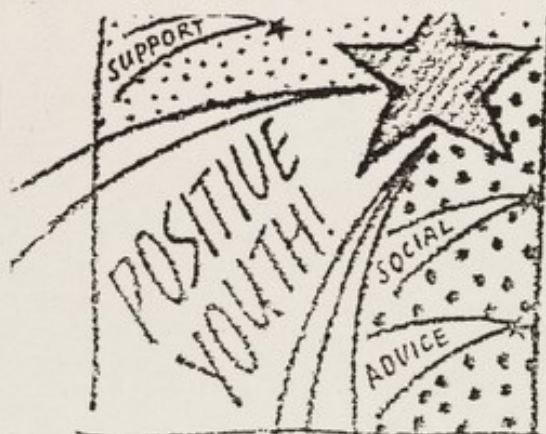
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Positive Youth is a group which gives support and information to young people (under 26) who have a positive HIV diagnosis.

As a part of Body Positive, a self-help group for people affected by HIV/AIDS, Positive Youth has access to a wide range of services and support groups, such as alternative therapies, legal advice and a wide range of social activities.

Positive Youth operates a range of support groups for young people. By the end of September, these groups will include: Drop-In/Social, Support/Counselling and a Young Women's group. These groups will take place at venues across London, and currently attract young people from all over the country.

Positive Youth also recognises the importance of social interaction for young people and offers social groups and outings as well as more formal support facilities.

Positive Youth is open to anybody under the age of 26, regardless of gender, sexuality, physical ability, lifestyle or ethnic origin.
