The new Southeast London Health Promotion Service provides a wide range of educational, developmental and consultative services to statutory, nonstatutory, voluntary and community agencies and individuals, on aspects relating to sexual health and HIV prevention. The service covers the three Health Authority boundaries of West Lambeth, Camberwell and Lewisham and North Southwark and the three London Boroughs of Lambeth, Southwark and Lewisham.

The service offers a wide range of leaflets, posters and educational materials to persons living or working in the Southeast London area. The service houses a substantial library of books, videos and teaching resources which may be of use to anyone interested in promoting a well informed positive attitude to sex, sexuality, HIV and STD prevention and those living with HIV. We are able to offer information and advice on a complex range of HIV prevention issues. Training is available to community groups to increase their understanding of issues related to HIV and AIDS. These services are available without charge.

We offer training, guidance and appropriate referral to workers and individuals on a broad spectrum of specific HIV prevention related areas:
