WHERE WE'RE GOING

The prime function of the District HIV Co-ordinating Centre is to facilitate the Procurement Role, at District level, of HIV care services and prevention. To this end it will:-

1

ASSESS needs for care provision and prevention/health promotion aspects of South Glamorgan's statutory and voluntary sector HIV-related services, in accordance with the policy recommendations of the HIV/Aids Advisory Committee, and within the professional competence of the officers at the Centre.

2

ASSESS District priorities in order to give the population better health care, advice, and information about the choice of services available in the most cost-effective manner.

3

ESTABLISH a database to provide a background of information and advice on the needs of the community, and resources available for the benefit of the HIV/AIDS Advisory Committee.

HOW WE GET THERE

1

CARE

Co-ordination of all aspects of care for people affected by HIV infection and AIDS.

2

HEALTH PROMOTION

Ensuring the provision of Health Promotion activities and the development of measures for the prevention of HIV infection in accordance with agreed strategies.

3

RESEARCH

To initiate, encourage and facilitate investigative research into preventive and care aspects of HIV infection.
