WHERE WE'RE GOING

The prime function of the District HIV Coordinating Centre is to facilitate the Procurement Role, at District level, of HIV care services and prevention. To this end it will:-

ESTABLISH a database to provide a background of information and advice on the needs of the community, and resources available for the benefit of the HIV/AIDS Advisory Committee.

CARE

Ensuring the provision of Health Promotion activities and the development of measures for the prevention of HIV infection in accordance with agreed strategies.



RESEARCH

To initiate, encourage and facilitate investigative research into preventive and care aspects of HIV infection.
