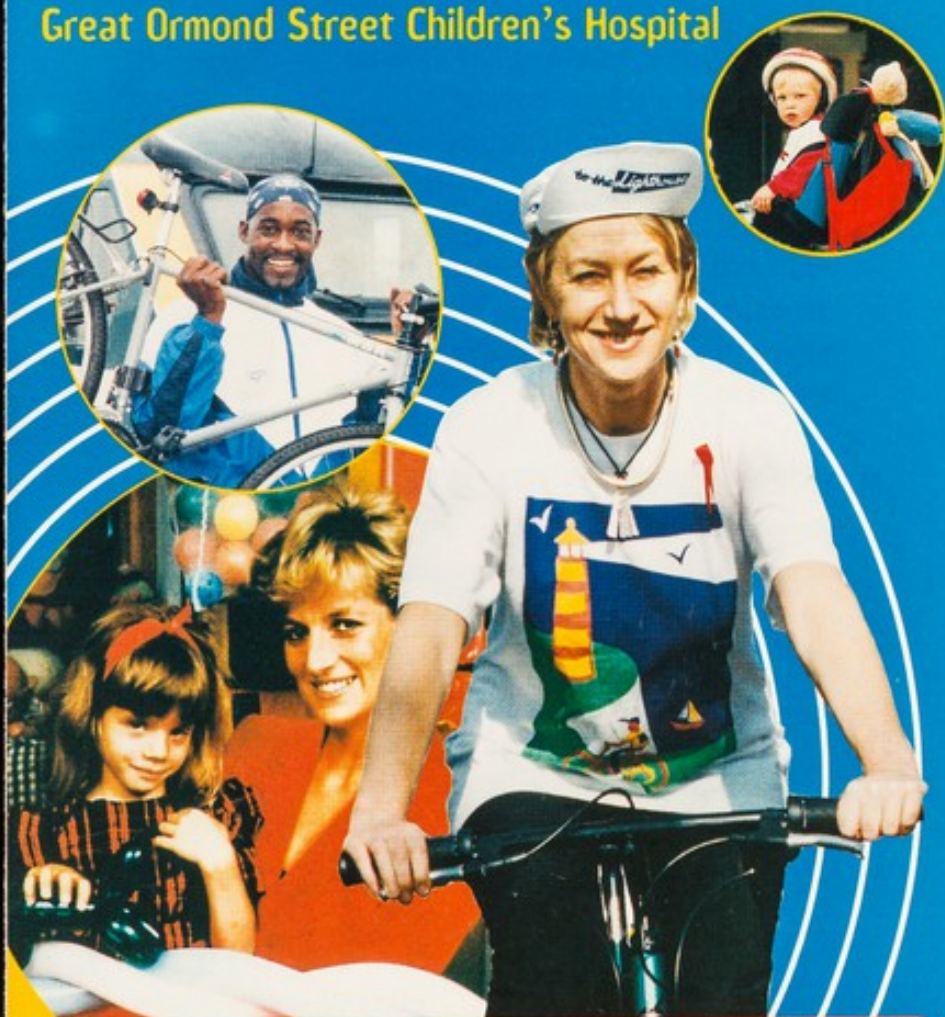

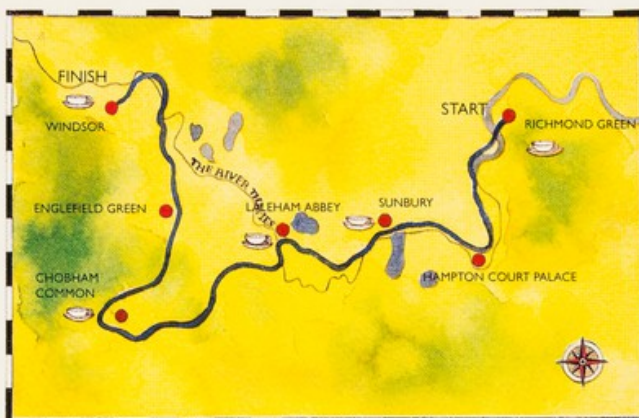
TRAINS
