COUNSELLING AND SEXUALITY Ref 90/4

DATES: 22-25TH FEBRUARY AND 5TH-8TH APRIL 1990.

An eight day course in two four day modules.

Module one provides participants with an opportunity to explore their own sexuality; consider the diversity of human sexuality; explore perceptions of the sexual needs of their clients; and become familiar with and practise a model of counselling appropriate to their work in this field.

Module two will be devoted to the application of the learning from the previous module to the counselling situation. Participants will have an opportunity to undertake intensive practice in the use of counselling skills in a one-to-one setting and in relation to the work situation.

Fees : £260 including lunch, tea and coffee.

SEXUALITY WORKSHOP FOR HIV/AIDS WORKERS

DATES: 28-30TH MARCH (Ref 90/18), 1ST-3RD OCTOBER (Ref 90/19).

A three day course, to be run twice in 1990, which aims to increase awareness, confidence and skills about sexuality for those who will be involved in education and training about HIV/AIDS, to enable them to work more effectively. Participants will be able to explore their own values and attitudes towards relationships and sexuality and how these affect their work; experience and practice approaches to sexuality education and training which they may use in their work around HIV/AIDS; practice appropriate communication and interpersonal skills with individuals and groups.

Fees: £100 including lunch, tea and coffee.

INTERPERSONAL RELATIONSHIPS AND SEXUALITY FOR PROFESSIONALS WORKING WITH YOUNG PEOPLE IN A COMMUNITY SETTING Ref 90/17

DATES: 9TH-11TH JULY.

A three day course to increase awareness, confidence and skills of professionals to enable them to work more effectively with young people in the area of personal and sexual relationships. Participants will be able to explore their own values and attitudes towards relationships and sexuality and how these affect their work; explore perceptions of the needs of young people in the field of relationships and sexuality; practise communication skills with individuals and groups, share relevant factual information and have an opportunity to review resources.

Fees: £100 including lunch, tea and coffee.

COUNSELLING AND HIV INFECTION (REF 90/66)

An eight day course in two four day modules.

Module one provides participants with an opportunity, though the use of experiential groupwork methods, to explore personal issues raised by HIV infection and consider how these might affect their work in this area; to share experiences of working with people affected by HIV infection; to consider some of the wider social issues raised by HIV infection; and to become familiar with and practice a model of counselling appropriate to their work in this field.

Module two will be devoted to the application of the learning from module one to the counselling situation. Participants will have an opportunity to undertake intensive practice in the use of counselling skills in both one-to-one and support/self help group settings.
