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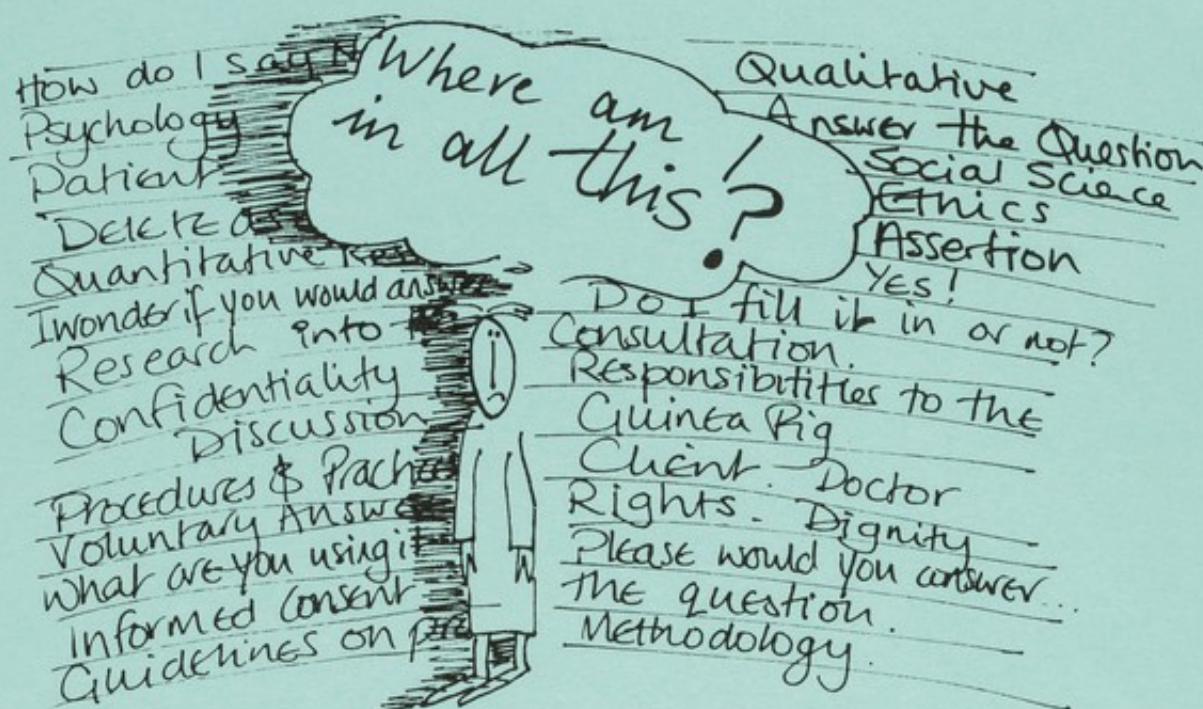

WHY THIS WORKSHOP?

AIDS involves us all, not just those with HIV infection. Our whole society is affected and as individuals we not only have to think about our behaviour but may be asked to take part in research. The ethical implications of some research are considered by some sponsors and professional bodies. However, there are no universally agreed guidelines and HIV/AIDS research, particularly in area of social behaviour, has highlighted issues which are not adequately covered by existing codes of practice.

This workshop is for researchers, funding bodies, media and the actual or potential subjects of social research. The aim is to discuss ethical issues of behavioural research, with special reference to HIV/AIDS, in relation to existing guidelines.
