In July 2000, the 13th bi-annual World AIDS Conference will be held in Durban, South Africa. These feedback sessions will be your chance to hear the latest information about the treatment for HIV. Each session, apart from the one in London, will be in two parts. The first part will be a basic session about HIV and its treatment, but will include any relevant information from the conference. Henry Grahame-Smith will facilitate this. By the end of this session those attending will understand:

### **Part One:**

- How the immune system works
- How HIV replicates
- CD4 count and viral load
- The different classes of anti-HIV drugs and how they work.
- Current thinking about what and when to start
- Resistance testing and its applications in anti-HIV treatment.

### **Part two:**

A doctor from the local area will join Henry for the second session. The topics covered during this session will depend on the information presented at the conference. However, it will be presented in such a way that all those attending can understand. There will be plenty of time to ask questions.
