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# EMERGENCY CONTRACEPTION

**If you have had sexual intercourse...**

- without using birth control
- or the condom burst/came off
- or your cap was faulty

**Emergency contraception can prevent pregnancy**

**Treatment will be effective if given within 72 hours (3 days) after intercourse**
