EPHEDRA-MA HUANG

Ephedrine is an alkaloid derived from Ephedra—Ma Huang. Similar to adrenalin both in chemical composition and therapeutic effect. Has the advantage of being effective by the mouth, whereas adrenalin must be injected. The response, though not so rapid, is more lasting.

Indicated chiefly in asthma and hay-fever.

Preparations

'TABLOID' BRAND EPHEDRINE HYDROCHLORIDE, gr. 1/4 [0.016 gm.]; and gr. 1/2 [0.032 gm.]

Gr. 1/4, in bottles of 25 and 100; gr. 1/2, in tubes of 6 and bottles of 25 and 100

'HYPOLOID' BRAND EPHEDRINE HYDROCHLORIDE, (Trade Mark) 0.03 gramme [gr. 1/2 approx.], in 1 c.c.

Hermetically-sealed phials of 1 c.c., in boxes of 10

'VAPOROLE' BRAND EPHEDRINE SPRAY COMPOUND (Trade Mark)

Bottles containing 1 fluid ounce

'ELIXOID' EPHEDRINE COMPOUND (Trade Mark)

Bottles containing 4 fluid ounces
