'LANOXIN' FOR INITIAL DIGITALISATION

Oral

Use 'Lanoxin' Tablets (bottles of 25, 100, 500 and 1000) or 'Lanoxin' Solution (bottles of 10 c.c. and 250 c.c.) A dose of 1.0 to 1.5 mgm. (4 to 6 tablets, 2 to 3 c.c. Solution), followed by 0.25 mgm. every 6 hours until ventricular rate is between 70 and 80 per minute.

Parenteral

Use 'Lanoxin' Injection (2 c.c. ampoules in boxes of 6) undiluted. A dose of 0.5 to 1 mgm. (1 to 2 ampoules) by slow injection, intravenously, every 2 to 4 hours as required.


'LANOXIN' FOR MAINTENANCE

Use 'Lanoxin' Tablets or Solution.

The average dose is 0.5 mgm. (2 tablets or 1 c.c. Solution) in divided doses by mouth each day.

'LANOXIN' FOR CHILDREN

Use 'Lanoxin' Paediatric Elixir (bottles of 2 fl. oz. with dropper). The average dose is 0.01 mgm. (0.2 c.c. of Paediatric Elixir) per lb. bodyweight daily. Initially, this is given every 6 hours.




