#### Indications

'Migril' is indicated in all forms of migraine.

#### Dosage

'Migril' should be taken at the first warning of an attack, 1 to 2 tablets initially, followed if necessary by ½ to 1 tablet at half-hourly or hourly intervals. The smallest effective dose should always be used and should never exceed 4 tablets for any single attack. Not more than 12 tablets should be taken in the course of a week. Children should be given proportionately less.

#### Side-Effects

Rarely there may be sensitivity to ergotamine; if, therefore, a patient feels a sensation of coldness or aching in the extremities, he should take no more tablets. Occasionally abdominal pain may occur.

#### **Contra-Indications**

'Migril' is contra-indicated in the presence of peripheral vascular disease, coronary disease, kidney and liver diseases, pregnancy and febrile conditions.
