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## What Flatulence really is.

**F**LATULENCE is caused through Bowel Indigestion, that is, failure to digest bread, potatoes, beans, and other starchy foods, all of which are digested in the bowel, but not in the stomach. If you wet such food as this, and put it in a bowl and keep it warm, it will ferment and create gases. This same kind of fermentation occurs in the bowel when this food is not digested.

## What Indigestion really is.

Indigestion is nothing but a failure to digest the daily food. In perfect health the food is first masticated in the mouth, where it is mixed with the saliva, and after being swallowed into the stomach it is acted upon by the gastric juices. About a quarter of it is digested in the stomach, the other three-quarters pass on into the bowel and is digested there. When the blood is pale and weak, and when there is Anæmia, the stomach and bowels are both weak, and unable to digest their food, and so require assistance. Further, when a person is overworking, or compelled to spend much of the day where the air is bad, there is often difficulty in digesting the food, and there again assistance is required. Thus you can understand what Indigestion is, and what causes the conditions which bring it about.



## Why Indigestion seldom . . . . Disappears without treatment.

Indigestion generally continues because the system is so rapidly weakened by even a short attack of Indigestion that the gastric juices become affected, and then the next food that is eaten is not digested, and that undigested food again helps to put the little glands, which make the gastric juice, still more out of order, and so gradually they become deranged, until they are incapable of digesting the ordinary food, and are not likely to recover until the proper medicine is taken.

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## Some Painful Symptoms of Indigestion. . . . .

When the food is not digested in the stomach and bowels, it becomes impure. In the bowel particularly it ferments, because the starchy part of the food, like bread and potatoes, is digested in the bowel, while the albuminous part, like eggs and meat, is digested in the stomach. When the fermentation begins gases form, and there is flatulence; this causes pressure, distress, and serious pains, and heart palpitation, and sudden feelings of weakness, cold hands and feet, heaviness of the head, pains and soreness at the back of the eyes; there is also a tenderness over the stomach, and eructations of gas at times. There is acidity and bad breath, and coated tongue, the liver is soon out of order, and there is biliousness and constipation, and kidney troubles, lack of appetite, sleeplessness, and yet a drowsy feeling often during the day, and no energy or desire for work.
