CHEST, decorated with carvings and inlay of the so-called « Carthusian » type. Lombardy. XVth century.

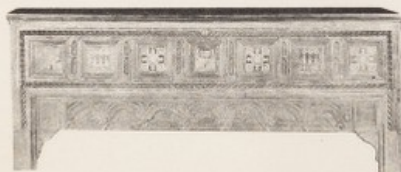
83.5 × 209 × 53 cm; walnut, inlaid in maple ebony and woods of various fruit trees.

The left side, lid and lower portion of the arch motif have been restored. The closing plate is missing.

The decoration of the front is divided into seven square panels, inlaid with various geometric, vegetable and architectonic motives on a series of blind arches. It is already of Renaissance style. Typical of the 15th century, it is decorated with sunken squares, while the height of the chest, the small niche-like inlays between the squares, and the twisted frame place this chest among works completed in the transition period. The motif of the row of embossed arches is found both in articles of German workmanship and those from Northern Italy.

**PACKINGS**

**ORAL FOR ADULTS** - Bottles of 16, 100 and 1000 capsules. Each capsule contains tetracycline-l-methylene-lysine 204 mg equivalent to 150 mg tetracycline base.

**ORAL FOR CHILDREN** - Boxes of 10 tablets. Each tablet contains tetracycline-l-methylene-lysine equivalent to 40 mg tetracycline base.

**INJECTION FOR ADULTS** - Boxes of 1 and 10 vials of 135 mg lyophilized tetracycline-l-methylene-lysine, equivalent to 100 mg tetracycline base with ampoules of solvent, each containing 40 mg procaine.

**INJECTION FOR CHILDREN** - Boxes of 1 and 10 vials of 67 mg lyophilized tetracycline-l-methylene-lysine, equivalent to 50 mg tetracycline base with ampoules of solvent each containing 20 mg procaine.

**DOSAGE**

Orally: Adults - 4 capsules daily in divided doses  
Children - 10 mg/kg/daily in divided doses

Intramuscularly: 2-3 vials daily in divided doses  
Dosage may be increased in the more serious cases.

**NHS COST:**

Tetralysal is the least expensive tetracycline available under the NHS.
