## Posological Table

## EAR, NOSE AND THROAT.

ANTRUM INFECTION. Instil 10% solution with other suitable measures.

ASTHMA. Dowling Argyrol pack treatment. Snugly fitting cotton wool swabs soaked in 10% solution and inserted high into both nostrils on wire or long probes. Keep in position 20 minutes. After withdrawal thoroughly cleanse the nares.

CHRONIC OTORRHOEA. Swab with 5% sol. COMMON WINTER COLD. Tampons soaked in 10% to 20% solution.

DEAFNESS in children. Instil few drops of 25% sol., follow by mineral oil spray.

ETHMOIDITIS. As for Asthma.

FURUNCULOSIS (nasal vestibule). Constantly apply nasal pack soaked with 20% solution.

HAY FEVER. Insert pledgets soaked in 10% solution. Retain for 15 to 30 minutes.

LARYNGITIS. Spray with 10% to 20% sol. NASAL INFECTIONS. Swab or spray nose with 20% solution.

OTITIS MEDIA. Cleanse and gently plug with gauze soaked in 10% to 20% sol. Water and Glycerine in equal parts.

PHARYNGITIS. Swab or spray with 20% to 30% solution every 4 hours.

POST-OPERATIVE Spray 20% solution in throat and nose or as drops in ear.

RHINITIS. Instil 20 minims of 10% sol. SINUSITIS. Cleanse nose and instil 5 drops of 10% solution.

TONSILITIS. As pharyngitis. TRACHEITIS. As laryngitis.

## **OPHTHALMOLOGY.**

CONJUNCTIVITIS.

Catarrhal, 10% to 25% solution, repeat frequently; instil also into nose.

Diphtheritic, 25% sol. eyes and nostrils.

Follicular, 10% to 15% solution.

Gonorrhoeal, Gentle, frequent, thorough cleansing and then instillations of 25% to 50% solution.

Ophthalmia Neonatorum, Frequent cleansing and instillations of 25% sol.

PRE- & POST-OPERATIVE. 15% instillations. TRACHOMA. Remove granulations. Apply 10% to 30% solutions.

## UROLOGY & GYNAECOLOGY.

CHANCROID. Cleanse and dry; then apply pure powdered Argyrol freely two or three times a day.

CYSTITIS. Irrigate bladder 1-500 solution;

then instil 1-ounce 10% solution.

GONORRHOEA (Male) Small syringe, Inject 3-10% solution T.D.S.

(Female) Inject 5-10% solution in urethra and bladder. Instil similar solution into cervical os. Insert vaginal tampon soaked in 20% solution for several hours each day.

GONORRHOEAL PROCTITIS. 1-500 rectal irrigations followed by injections of 10% solution.

PYELITIS. Inject per ureter catheter 1-500 solution or stronger up to 5%.

VAGINAL DISCHARGE, same as Gonorrhoea. VULVO-VAGINITIS (children). Swab vulva with and instil into vagina 10% solution.
