Dosage: Usually 20-30mg daily. For more severe hypertension – 40mg daily increasing to 100mg if necessary.

Side effects: Faintness, diarrhoea, nasal congestion, paraesthesia, myalgia or muscle weakness, aggravation of intermittent claudication and failure of ejaculation have been reported, which are often an indication of excessive dosage.

Contra-indicated in the presence of phaeochromocytoma.

Precautions: Use with caution in patients with renal failure or raised blood level urea and those with a history of peptic ulceration. MAO inhibitors, tricyclic antidepressants and amphetamines tend to antagonise the hypotensive actions of Ismelin which may also be enhanced by alcohol or anaesthetic agents.
