INDICATIONS	PACKAGES	DOSAGE
Shock, heart asthenia following infectious diseases (pneumonia, etc.), arterio-sclerosis, renal affections, bronchial asthma, emphysema, poisoning through narcotics, asphyxia of the new-born, etc.	Coramine Liquid, for oral administration (Vials of 15 cc. and 100 cc.). Coramine Ampoules, 1 cc., for hypodermic and intravenous use (Boxes of 5, 20 and 100).	1 to 2 cc. of the Liquid, with a little water, orally. 1 to 2 Ampoules, hypodermically, intramuscularly or intravenously.
