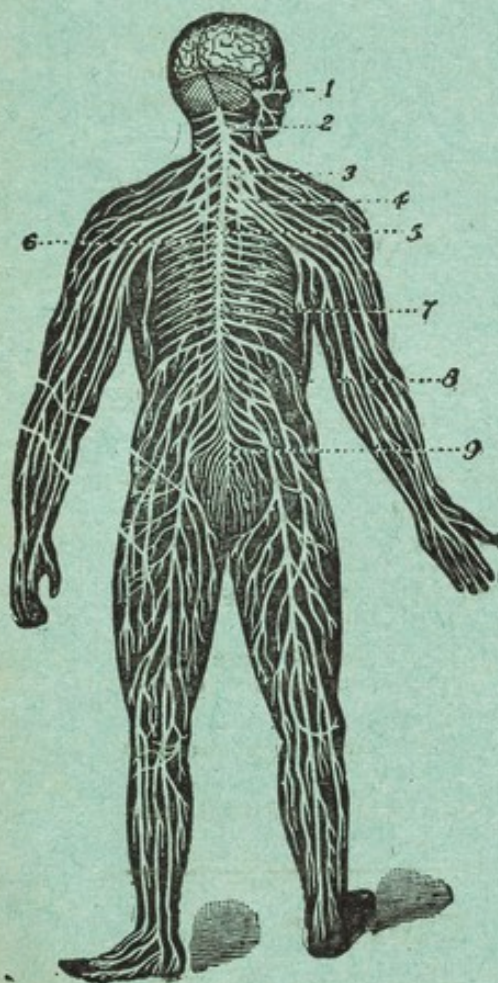


Diagram of Nervous System illustrating Coutts' Spinal System of Treatment.
