Uses

Topical treatment of eczema, dermatitis and all types of inflammatory, pruritic and allergic skin conditions. In view of its safety, Dioderm is particularly recommended for treating children.

Directions

Rub well into the lesions twice daily or more often if necessary.

Contra-indications, warnings etc.

As with all topical steroids, Dioderm is contra-indicated in the presence of viral or fungal infections, tubercular or syphilitic lesions and in bacterial infections unless used in conjunction with appropriate chemotherapy. It should not be applied extensively in pregnancy i.e. in large amounts or for long periods. In infants, long term continuous topical therapy should be avoided.

Pharmaceutical precautions

Dioderm should be stored in a cool place.

Dioderm is subject to the Therapeutic Substances Act and is therefore available on prescription only.

Package quantities

Dioderm is packaged in 30 gram collapsible tubes.

Dioderm is a significant advance in the formulation of a topical hydrocortisone preparation. It has been shown to be considerably more active than other hydrocortisone preparations including those containing urea.
