CAPER SPURGE (*Euphorbia lathyris*. Family: *Euphorbiaceae*)

Caper Spurge contains a milky juice which is an irritant poison and the oil contained in the seeds is a drastic purgative. The juice of the spurges has been used by African tribes in the preparation of arrow-poisons.

Poisonous constituent: euphorbone.

Treatment: demulcents, gastric lavage and symptomatic treatment.
