The active toxic principle of White Bryony is a glycoside, bryonin, which is a drastic purgative. The whole plant contains an acrid and irritant milky juice, but nevertheless the roots have caused poisoning when eaten mistakenly as parsnips or turnips or as a result of the belief that they will diminish milk secretion in lactating women. The root and berries are particularly poisonous. *Poisonous constituent:* bryonin.

Treatment: gastric lavage, demulcents, relief of colic and abdominal discomfort

and prevention of gross dehydration.
