Side-effects

Duphaston has no serious side-effects, and no greater incidence of minor effects than with placebo.

Contraindications

There are no known contraindications to the use of Duphaston.

Other Indications

Duphaston is effective in the management of threatened and habitual abortion, endometriosis and infertility due to corpus luteum insufficiency.
