 4½ grs.

 Kaolin
 90 grs.

 Zinc Phenolsulphonate
 1½ grs.

THERAPEUTICS: Pectocel combines the adsorptive effect of kaolin in adequate dosage with the intestinal antiseptic properties of zinc phenol-sulphonate. It is of particular value where it is desired to avoid opium or the sulphonamides. Alternatively it may be combined with more specific therapy.

DOSE: In ACUTE CONDITIONS two to four tablespoonfuls may be given every hour or two for three or four doses, then two tablespoonfuls every three or four hours. In CHRONIC CONDITIONS one or two tablespoonfuls every three or four hours. In CHILDREN the dosage should be proportionate to age and severity of the condition.
