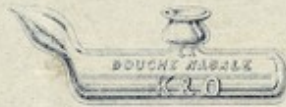

Enclosed are three samples of postals taken of a soldier I treated with glyco for a wound from an explosive bullet. Exit of wound measured 2 x 6 x 2 inches deep when the patient arrived at Beauville Casino. I treated him solely with glyco, syringing out the pockets & cutting away the gangrenous flesh, then cleansing with hot glyco & applying glyco compresses every 6 hours.

The man called at the office a few days ago when I had the wound photographed with the major. It will be noticed that the wound is perfectly cicatrised. Illustrations of this case appeared in the London medical journals, about which I wrote you in my last letter.
