Why spots?

The persistent spots and pimples which doctors call acne are almost always caused by over-activity of the tiny glands which occur just below the surface of the skin. These glands provide the natural oils the skin needs but sometimes they produce more than enough. Result—over-greasy skin.

The first and most common stage is the formation of black-heads. The second stage appears as small swellings which are inflamed. Unless given proper and early attention there is a danger of germs causing 'secondary' infection which may result in permanent scarring.

Acne is one of the most common skin complaints particularly among young people, of both sexes, between the ages of 12 and 25, though older people can also suffer. Spots and pimples associated with acne are usually found on the back, shoulders, chest and especially the face.

If you are in any doubt that your spots and pimples are associated with acne or if you find Medac does not clear the condition within a reasonable period you should consult your doctor.

Why MEDAC

Medac is the result of many years experience in dermatology. The active ingredients it contains have been thoroughly endorsed by the medical profession and skin specialists for the treatment of spots and pimples associated with acne. How to use MEDAC

At night time wash the face and any other affected area thoroughly — the best soap to use is Medac Soap, specially formulated to remove excess grease from the skin. Dry with a clean towel. Using a clean fingertip not a flannel or sponge, apply a film of Medac Cream over the whole of the affected area taking care to avoid contact with the eyes. *Leave on all night.*



In the morning wash carefully and rinse, first with hot water, then cold. Dry thoroughly. Apply a thin film of Medac Cream over the spots and blemishes and smooth away the edges so that the Cream blends with the surrounding skin. Girls will find that makeup can be used over Medac very satisfactorily. You can use Medac more often if it seems necessary.

After the spots have cleared you will probably find that the regular use of Medac Soap alone will be enough to prevent their return.

But, keep a tube of Medac Cream by you always to deal with persistent spots quickly.



MEDAC Cream is specially formulated for the external treatment of spots and pimples associated with the acne condition. The particular active agents in MEDAC are designed to produce a mild drying effect so should your skin begin to feel a little dry this proves MEDAC is doing its job. If, however, your skin becomes too dry for comfort discontinue the treatment for a day or two and then resume Medac application less frequently.

Hints on General Hygiene



As well as using Medac for the treatment of spots, pimples and acne there are many other things that you can do to combat these skin blemishes.

1. Always keep your skin thoroughly clean.
2. Avoid squeezing and pressing the pimples and blackheads—dangerous infection may result.
3. Eat plenty of fresh fruit and salads.
4. Avoid highly seasoned dishes.
5. Girls should not use cosmetics with an oily base.
6. Fresh air and exercise are important—take plenty of both.

Care of the Hair

Dandruff is very often associated with the excessively greasy skin conditions that cause spots. So you should not be surprised to find signs of dandruff in your hair. The easiest and pleasantest way to treat dandruff is with a medicated shampoo. You are advised to use Sebbix which is recommended by doctors for the elimination of dandruff. Sebbix not only gets rid of dandruff but keeps the hair lovely. Use Sebbix shampoo regularly and dandruff will never be a problem to you.
