Indications

Steroid-responsive dermatoses of the scalp such as psoriasis and seborrhoea capitis.

Application

Betnovate Scalp Application is issued in a plastic squeeze bottle with an elongated nozzle. The nozzle passes through the hair so that the liquid is applied only to the affected area. There is therefore no need to rub the liquid into the scalp. A small quantity of Betnovate Scalp Application should be applied morning and night until improvement is noticeable; it may then be possible to sustain improvement by applying once a day or less frequently.

Precautions

Betnovate Scalp Application is usually well tolerated. If occlusive dressings are used for an extensive area of the scalp over long periods, the possibility of systemic absorption, as can occur with any topical steroid, should be borne in mind. Absorption is more likely in infants and children, and may occur even in the absence of occlusion. Care must be taken to keep the preparation away from the eyes. Betnovate Scalp Application, being spirituous, is flammable and may damage polished surfaces.
