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New approach to

manufacture

Cortisone, one of the most complicated of the synthetic organic compounds yet introtuced into medical practice, has now been synthesised by Glaxo Laboratories in this country using a new process devised jointly with the National Institute for Medical Research. This new development utilises, as starting material, hecogenin derived from East African sisal waste. The synthesis is therefore of practical importance to the National economy because it avoids the need for dollar imports. At the same time it promises more plentiful supplies of this important drug for the National Health Service.

The new method of manufacture will shortly be put into full-scale production and then, from start to finish, Cortelan (cortisone Glaxo) will be made in the United Kingdom from materials produced in sterling areas.
